CDL Driver and Equipment Operator (Landscape Division)

The CDL Driver and Equipment Operator position is responsible for providing safe and client focused services to both new and long-term clients by delivering landscape materials and equipment to jobsites. The CDL Driver will coordinate with multiple staff members and management team to ensure timely and safe delivery. In addition to driving and operating equipment, the position may require use of hand tools and requires the ability to lift up to 80lbs independently. The CDL Driver may be required to work on multiple sites in a day/week. Out of town work is sometimes required on a rotating basis, dependent on current job schedule. This position will communicate effectively with clients, crew members, and members of management team. The ideal candidate is both self-sufficient and a team player. Heavy equipment operating experience preferred, but not required.

Because this position requires direct contact with clients, candidate must be fluent in English, including speaking, reading, and writing.

Work will be performed outdoors with varying weather conditions. This position may be required to work in adverse weather, including high-heat, high winds, and heavy rain. Exceptions include excessive heat, freezing temperatures, smoke events, and other situations as necessary.

This is a full-time position that qualifies for health insurance, PTO, and retirement. Qualified candidates are required to pass a pre-employment drug screening. Valid Oregon driver's license with a Class A CDL certification with a valid medical examiner's certificate and a clean driving record is required.
